Iowa Cultural Corridor Alliance

The Iowa Cultural Corridor Alliance (ICCA) is an alliance of over 150 cultural organizations in a region of East Central Iowa known as the Corridor. ICCA defines the Corridor as Linn and Johnson Counties, as well as the nine adjacent counties to them. The mission of ICCA is to promote the varied cultural activities of its partner organizations and to nurture a sustainable cultural community. This is done through promotion of cultural events through electronic, print, radio, and television communication, facilitation of cross-Corridor communication and collaborations, professional development programming, and by building strong relationships throughout the Corridor community.

Partnership

ICCA Partnerships are reserved for nonprofit arts, cultural, and governmental organizations. Examples include museums, libraries, performing arts centers, performing companies, and music groups. Other nonprofit organizations whose mission is not focused on arts and culture may join with board approval. Partners of ICCA are voting members of the organization.

Annual Dues

Iowa Cultural Corridor Alliance Partnership dues are an annual fee. Partnership dues are based on the size of the organization's budget. Partnership fees are:

Individual/All Volunteer:	\$50.00
Budget up to \$199,999:	\$100.00
\$200,000-\$299,999:	\$200.00
\$300,000+:	\$300.00

A one-time \$150.00 development fee to assist in underwriting the costs of the Cultural Corridor website, www.culturalcorridor.org, will also be assigned to the organization at the time of their initial application. This fee will not be charged again even if partnership with ICCA lapses.

Future yearly dues must be received on or prior to your organization's renewal date. You will receive a renewal notice from the Iowa Cultural Corridor Alliance to remind you to renew your partnership agreement. Your organization's renewal date will be the date that your account is set up on the Cultural Corridor website by an ICCA staff member. If your partnership application is denied, your check will be returned to you.

Once approved, your organization will be contacted with a username and password to allow you to access to the Cultural Corridor website to post your organization profile and events online.
