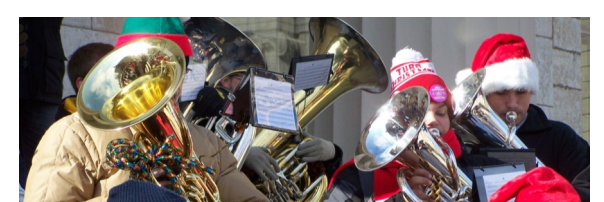
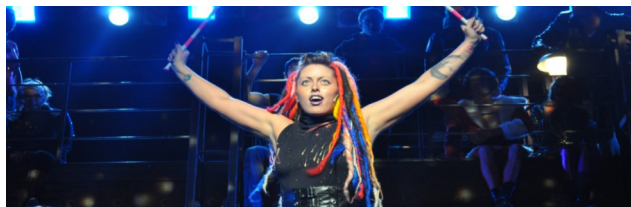
# There is always something going on in the Corridor!
